Main responsibilities

- Undertake field layout for winter barley trials
- Seed preparation and planting the trials with the plot seeder
- Preparation of draft field maps for winter barley trials
- Agronomic data collection and analysis in winter barley trials during the growing season
- Preparation of field labels, tags and field books for winter barley trials
- Monitoring of disease spreads in winter barley trials and disease incidence scoring
- Supervise visitors and daily labours needed for weed control, planting and harvesting
- Threshing, seed processing and conservation in the barley seed store
- Supervision of yearly crossing activities
- Contribute to publications and prepare scientific presentation material
- Respond to external and internal inquiries for technical information
- Assist the winter barley breeder and Turkey country manager in any other requested technical activities.
- The position will be based in Ankara, however if needed, the incumbent might travel to the other locations in Turkey.

Essential qualifications and competencies

- MSc graduate from Agricultural Engineering in pathology or plant breeding and agronomy with 3 years of relevant experience. BSc may be accepted if complemented by substantive additional years of relevant experience (at least six).
- Intermediate knowledge in English writing and data recording and entry.
- Good knowledge of working with computer (Microsoft Office software).
- Strong analytical skills.
- Ability to work effectively with multinational and multicultural teams.
- Turkish nationality.
- Valid driving license in Turkey.
