Senior Research Assistant – Promotion of candidate varieties from wild crosses

Main purpose of position

ICARDA has received funds to conduct variety research primarily in Morocco for durum wheat, barley, and lentil. The type of candidate varieties to be promoted are derived from crosses made with wild relatives of these crops. The successful candidate shall oversee all operations related to this project, with a specific focus on testing the best candidates across locations primarily in Morocco, but also interact with local and international partners from Ethiopia, Lebanon, and Senegal. Testing shall be conducted both on station and on farm. Participatory variety selection with farmers is a critical component of this job. In addition, stability analysis and application of weighted selection indexes are required to identify the best candidates for potential release. The hired person will also be required to collect high quality scientific data, support the design of meaningful breeding and social experiments, and contribute to the drafting of annual reports and scientific articles.
